Trophies will be presented at the Fishing Section Prize Giving and Awards on Sunday 1st July 2018. Awards will also be made for second and third in each category.

Notes:

1. In the event that members having an equal score on the 31st May, the winner will be decided on:
 - a. By the highest sum of fish weights in kg and/or fish lengths per angler, if still a draw then
 - b. First Recorded Fish entered either on the Brag Board, or in a MBBC Fishing Contest.
2. Scoring commences from the 1st June 2017.
3. Fish must be caught in Chart NZ 532 or the Firth of Thames.
4. Meritorious catches must be caught within NZ Waters.
5. Contest is open to all MBBC members only.
6. Points scored for entering fish on the brag board shall be the heaviest fish of each species added on any single day. Where multiple fish of the same species are weighed in, only the heaviest shall earn a point towards the angler of the year. Details of the catch must be recorded in the weigh station log books by the angler.
